Results will be available by June 2024.

The project must be submitted according to the attached guidelines and the application form must be filled in.

Evaluation of the grant proposal will be based on the scientific originality, whether the research is patient-oriented, the feasibility of the project and the visibility for the AIRG-Suisse.
